- People can participate from home or gather in small groups where the wifi/internet connections are better. Congregation council leaders should make this gathering a priority.
- The weather will not be a factor.
- Any member of an NGLS congregation is welcome to participate and there is no limit to how many people can join.

A ZOOM link will be sent via email to every pastoral leader and interim who will then forward it to their own congregation's email list.

- Please take note of the password that will come with the link. You will be asked to enter it in order to join the meeting.
- The programming portion of the meeting will be about 90 minutes. It will include:
 - Dwelling in the Word – 15 minutes
 - What is the “Year of Discovery?” – 30 minutes including small groups.
 - A presentation on the new Lifelong Faith Formation initiative.
 - Group participation in upcoming Synod-wide worship for Reformation Sunday.
 - State of the Synod update.
- Conferences will have the option of staying on for another 30 minutes to attend to conference business (elections, conversation, etc), or scheduling an official conference meeting for another time.
