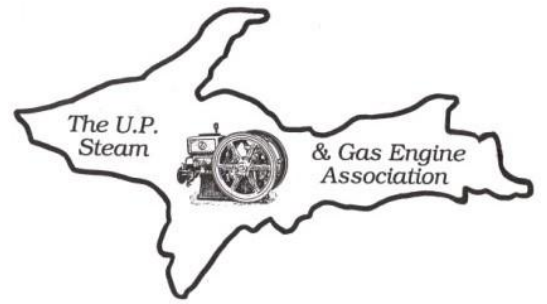
~ REMINDERS TO MEMBERSHIP ~
