Membership Meeting @ Antique Village Community Building at 6:30 p.m. Membership Meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month.

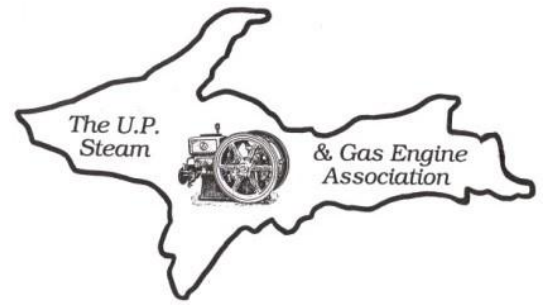
~ REMINDERS TO MEMBERSHIP ~
