9. Replace trim on Blacksmith Shop
10. Get Mack engine on tracks
11. Community Hall (Need some trim on a few windows)
12. Cover gas regulator on Ice Cream Shop
13. Put awning on Sock Shop
14. Repair back wall on Ice Cream Shoppe
15. Baseboards on front of Granary

~ REMINDERS TO MEMBERSHIP ~

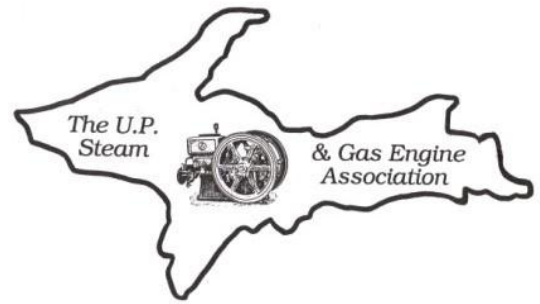
